

Assistant Sub-Inspector Amarjit Singh, No. 221/CHG



ASI Amarjit Singh was born on 18.05.1956 at village-Sarahla, District-Hoshiarpur, Punjab. He had 02 brothers and 03 sisters. He passed Pre-University class from Khalsa College, Garhdiwala, District Hoshiarpur, in 1975.

He joined the Chandigarh Police as Constables on 26.07.1976, on dated 04.05.2008 he was promoted to the rank of Head Constable and was promoted as ASI on 02.09.1988.

On 08.12.1989, ASI Amarjit Singh while posted in Police Post-36, Chandigarh was on patrolling duty in Nehru Colony at village-Kajheri, on his scooter. At about 08:15PM he was chased by two young Sikh person on a Motorcycle on his way to Nehru Colony. When he reached near the colony, the above motorcyclist attacked him with fire arms. ASI Amarjit Singh tried

to save himself by taking shelter in a Jhuggi but one of the motorcyclist fired upon him hitting in his head. ASI Amarjit Singh immediately fell down from his scooter and died on the spot.

In this regard case FIR No. 290 dated 08.12.1989 u/s 302, 34 IPC and 25, 27,54/59 Arms Act, Police Station-39, Chandigarh was registered on the statement of Shri Hem Raj S/O Ram Dass, R/o Jhuggi No. 430, Nehru Colony, Village-Kajheri, Chandigarh.

During more than 13 years of his service in Chandigarh Police he had earned 07 Commendation Certificates Class-III with cash of Rs 25/-.
