On dated 18/02/2013, in the wee hours, PCR helped the local police in arresting two thieves who have stolen the Maruti Car No. PB12-F-0469 from Sector-20, Chandigarh in short span of time. At about 2 am, Police Control Room got the information that a Maruti Zen Car No. PB12-F-0469 stolen from Sector-20, Chandigarh. Message was immediately flashed to all stations. At about 2.20 am, PCR vehicle Sugar-6 noticed that the same Maruti Car approaching toward Tribune chowk, when signaled to stop, it fled away toward Hallomajra. Sugar-6 started chasing the car and passed the message to PCR and Sugar-3 stationed at Hallo majra chowk. The above said Maruti car can't be intercepted at Hallo majra chowk also and it took the left turn toward Mouli Jagran. Since the message was passed to all PCR vehicles, ultimately occupant of car left the car in starting position at Railway crossing near Mouli Jagran tried to ran away. In the meantime, PCR Cheeta Motorcycles Cheeta-18 & Cheeta-28 chased the running thieves and over powered them in a muddy area and ultimately caught two persons and stolen Maruti Car was recovered. A case FIR No.26 u/s 379/411/34 IPC dated 18/02/2013 has been registered in PS-19. **Both accused Jaswinder and Karaj Singh resident of Village Dharaskot, District Moga Punjab presently staying at Sector-34, Chandigarh were arrested.**
